What is 2-1-1?

- ◆ **2-1-1** is a **non-emergency health and human services** information and referral service that makes it easy for people to get connected with the appropriate community-based organizations and government agencies that can help them. It provides simple access to often complex and hard to find services.
- ◆ In addition to the **free, confidential 24/7 phone service**, people may also **search for services online**.

EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

In an **emergency**, always call **9-1-1**. An emergency is any situation in which someone needs immediate help because he or she is injured or in immediate danger.


When should I call 2-1-1? Here are some questions 2-1-1 can help answer:

- ◆ Are there parenting classes or resources available for new parents in my community?
- ◆ How can I find out about health insurance options?
- ◆ I just lost my job, and it's tough to afford food. Where can I get help?
- ◆ I want to go to college, but I don't know where to start. Who can help me?
- ◆ Are there any resources to assist someone starting a small business?
- ◆ My parents are getting a divorce, and it's really hard for me. Who can I talk to?
- ◆ As I'm getting older, I'm finding that it's harder to do everything I used to. Who provides help for seniors?
- ◆ My parents don't speak English very well, but they need help. Are there any services that have interpreters available?



When you need information about community services or volunteer opportunities, or are looking for help with a personal or family matter, **we're here any time you don't know where to turn.**

How do I use 2-1-1?

- 1) Call **2-1-1**, 715-848-2255, or 1-800-922-5590. Speak with one of our Information Specialists who can connect you with agencies that can meet your current needs. Information Specialists are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- 2) Email United Way's 2-1-1 at askus@unitedwaymc.org. One of our Information Specialists will work to answer your questions. In order to make the process smoother, please provide a detailed description of your need and your city of residence in your email.
